FRAUD ALERT!

Please read this information carefully.

If you can answer **YES** to **ANY** of the following questions, please contact the Better Business Bureau or the US Postal Inspection Service immediately. You may have been a victim of a scam or fraudulent activity.

- Have you received information by US mail, over the Internet, or by telephone that you have won money in a lottery or sweepstakes that you do not remember entering?
- Have you been asked to wire money or send a cashiers check to cover fees, taxes, tariffs or other charges for winning a lottery or sweepstakes?
- Have you been asked to give or verify any personal information over the telephone, Internet, or through the mail when you have not initiated the contact?
- Have you been offered a commission to assist in the transfer of money?
- Have you ever seen purchases on your credit card invoices that were not made by you?
- Has someone offered to pay you more than the purchase price for merchandise you are selling over the internet?
